Our speaker, Eric Quaempts, Head of the DNR at the Umatilla Indian Reservation. He is also the interim Executive Director of the Tribes. His presentation was on First Foods and their management and importance. He did a wonderful job, even connecting it to the AAUW statement of purpose.

1. The minutes were accepted as printed in the Newsletter.
2. Finance report presented by Karen King, Finance VP. The balances as of 5/15/18 were: checking, \$1,943 and savings, \$7,371.75 A lot of that money will be passed on to State and National for dues. She also reported that only 2 of the 6 GED vouchers we have purchased at BMCC have been used.
